What inspired you to become a Youth Support Worker?

Dealing with the diversity of thoughts, behaviours, and actions makes this work a unique learning experience that's

hard to find in other fields. The opportunity to help young people and witness their progress in first-hand has always seemed like a powerful motivation for me to start working in this area.

What do you enjoy most about your job?
